



WHAT IS HSA?

Did you know that the moment you register your child(ren) at Saint Martha School you become a member of the Saint Martha School Home and School Association (HSA)?

The Home and School Association (HSA) is a volunteer organization made up of Saint Martha School parents/guardians whose purpose is to enhance the experience of our school community. The HSA sponsors and helps with events such as the Fall Festival, Back to School popsicles for students, Trunk-or-Treat, Teacher Appreciation Week, Teacher Appreciation Luncheon, Family Christmas Night, Barnes & Noble Night, Dinner Nights Out, Sports Games (Thunderbirds and Yard Goats), Grandparent's Day, Book Fairs, Field Day, fundraisers, and so much more!

These events are funded in part by Saint Martha School families Annual Dues of \$10.00 per year/per family. The \$10.00 dues are billed to families Smart Tuition Accounts.

The HSA runs several fundraisers throughout the school year to raise money for various events and to purchase needed items for the school to improve all of our children's educational experience.

Everything we do is possible because of our volunteers, and each one of you is already a member of the HSA! Each family is required to complete 15 volunteer hours per school year, with the exception of Pre-K. We have many day and evening opportunities available throughout the year to complete your hours including the events listed above and some unique ideas if you cannot join us in person; for example, donating food and drinks for various events will earn volunteer credit!

The HSA meets on the third Thursday of each month (with exceptions for holidays and school events - changes to the schedule will be announced) to discuss events, plan fundraisers to enhance school programs, and share ideas. Everyone is welcome to attend these meetings as all Saint Martha School Families are members of the HSA. This is a wonderful way to find out, and be a part of, what is happening at our school!
